As part of the Columbine Unitarian Universalist Church (CUUC) community, I aspire to:

- Speak and act with kindness, care, acceptance, and open mind;
- Speak and listen with honesty, remembering that someone else's truth may differ from my own;
- Assume positive intent, and if I am confused about that intent, ask;
- Listen deeply and seek to understand perspectives different from my own;
- When in disagreement, speak directly and privately with those involved in an effort to resolve differences;

- Maintain boundaries, and articulate them as necessary;
- Seek support from the Shared Ministry Team if efforts to resolve a dispute are unsuccessful;
- None of us is perfect; therefore, do not expect perfection from others or from myself;
- Forgive others and compassionately invite them back into covenant when it is broken;
- Forgive myself if I break covenant, and redouble my efforts to right relationships.
